- ✓ We Welcomed back our Year 6 pupils from North Wales and welcomed our final group EYFS pupils. It's lovely to have everyone back and it's been a very busy week.
- ✓ This week's attendance for EYFS and Key Stage 1 was 95.6% and for Key Stage 2 it was 96.8%. Slightly lower than last week for both schools.
