Year 6 Summer Newsletter

We can't quite believe that we are now in the final term of primary school for your children. It's an action-packed term and this newsletter aims to give you an overview of the events ahead. Homework

We have now completed most of the SATs buster books. Please encourage your child to complete any missing tests from these books if they have spare time. Once a book is completed, please encourage your child to use it as a revision tool for any concepts they are unsure of. Homework will continue after SATs and it is important for your child to get themselves into a regular routine as part of the transition process. We will be setting homework online using Purple Mash as this will help with the transition to secondary school. We will aim to set activities linked to current learning in school and children will find the set activities in their 2do section. Work will be marked online and merits and gems give using the feedback tool. On the rare occasion that Purple Mash will not let you hand a piece of work in after it has been completed, just get your child to let





us know – they will not have to complete it again. If your child does not have access to a device to complete their homework, then a paper alternative will be available.

We are continuing to broaden your child's range of genre that they read through encouraging them to complete a reading variety log, which can be found at the back of their reading journals. Please get them to read at least four times a week and record it themselves. This could be: a summary; interesting vocabulary; predictions or answers to the questions from the middle of their journal. We spend time in school practising spellings. Your child will bring home a set spelling list focusing on the rule. They can also use the spelling lists in the middle of their journals to keep track of words they revise from the Year 5/6 spelling lists.
