

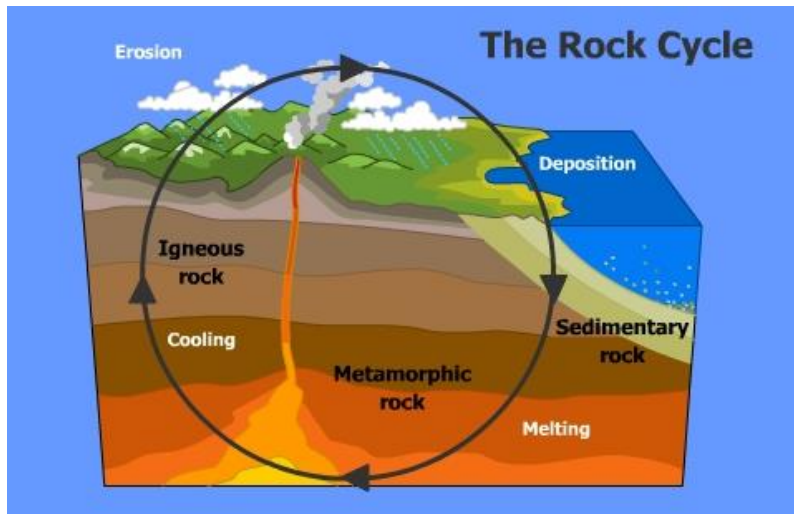
Rocks and Soil

Igneous rocks – these are formed from molten rock (lava) that has cooled and solidified.














Sedimentary rocks – are formed by the accumulation or deposition of small particles that make layers.

Metamorphic rocks– are formed from other rocks which have changed due to heat or pressure.
