This week at Parsons Down...

- ✓ This week's **attendance** for EYFS and Key Stage 1 was 95.6% and for Key Stage 2 it was 93.6%.
- ✓ Children in Years 1 to 6 have been working incredibly hard on their **end of term assessments**. Termly assessment is not a new thing at Parsons Down but we have added to our assessment process to gain even more information about how well the children are doing and any gaps so we can adjust teaching accordingly. We'll update you in our next parents' evening before half term.
- ✓ **This week's sporting fixtures** have seen the U11 boys' and girls' teams braving some very muddy pitches! This was part of the ESFA league so nearer home this time. Both teams played incredibly well and we're very proud of them. The girls have made it through to the next round but unfortunately the boys were knocked out.
- ✓ We have launched our first ever **Christmas writing competition**. More details were emailed out on Friday. Infant pupils can enter by drawing a Christmas picture and labelling it OR write a short Christmas story (up to 300 words). Junior pupils are being challenged to write a short story (up to 500 words). Entries need to be brought in by Friday 12th December. The School Council will be judging the entries.
- ✓ The **Eco Council** continue to be busy. Well done to everyone who took part in the Cut your Carbon challenge and logged it on Purple Mash. We're busy awarding gems to those that took part. The children met earlier in the week with Miss Hargood and planned an Eco-friendly Christmas assembly for next week.
- ✓ The **School Council** have also been busy.
