- ✓ This week's **attendance** for EYFS and Key Stage 1 was 96% and for Key Stage 2 it was 95.6%.
- ✓ We are incredibly proud of the 28 Year 6 children that completed their Level 2 Bikeability Training this week. Their behaviour was exemplary and they were a credit to the school. We hope that they enjoy putting their new-found skills to the test on the local roads as the cycle safely around the local area. - ✓ We've noticed an influx of very large pencil cases and other items from home that are causing a huge distraction in the classroom. We are a well-resourced school and we have plenty of stationery items in the classrooms and SEAL club. If the items distract learning or shouldn't be in school we will ask the children to put them away or keep them at home.
- ✓ We've sent out the Parents' Evening appointment letters with the children today. Please can you complete and return them by Friday 11th October. We will send home the appointment times by Friday 18th October.
- ✓ If you need to **communicate with the school** there are lots of different channels to do so. The school office is open 8.30am-3.30pm daily.
