We ended the term with a very memorable assembly this morning with some star performances from the 12 days of Christmas. This was followed by Partnership Play.
- ✓ This week's **attendance** for EYFS and Key Stage 1 was only 88.7% and for Key Stage 2 it was 91.6%.
- ✓ On Monday, the Partnership walked to St Mary's church for our annual Carol Concert. The children sang beautifully, our choir treated us to two magnificent songs and our Year 6 readers retold the Christmas story with clarity and purpose. Also a huge thank you to the volunteers who helped us walk safely there and back.
- ✓ I can't believe we are already nearly a third of the way through the academic year. We're busy preparing for the spring term. Year groups newsletters will be emailed out to all families by Monday 15th January. In the new year we will be **reinforcing uniform expectations**. In particular, those relating to health and safety. Long hair should be fully tied back, earrings must only be studs (no hoops), We would also like to remind you that trainers are only for PE/playtimes/MUGA. Children should be wearing black school shoes. However, we are also allowing children to wear sensible boots in winter. - ✓ If you registered an interest in your child attending one of our **after school clubs** you should have received a slip to confirm they have a place. The clubs will start in the week beginning 8th Jan 2024, and the last club date will be on Thursday 1st Feb 2024. Children attending after school clubs will need to be collected promptly from the school reception area at 4pm. If your child is allocated a space, we expect commitment and positive behaviour. Children must only attend a club when they have received a confirmation slip indicating a place has been allocated.
- ✓ It was Mrs Blair's final day at Parsons Down today. She will be leaving us for a new teaching position nearer home. She's worked at Parsons Down for 20 years and will be greatly missed. We wish her well in the future. In January, Miss Nunn will be returning to Parsons Down after her maternity leave. This will mean some cover changes in the new year.

On Monday we walked to the church and on Tuesday it was Christmas Craft Day.




