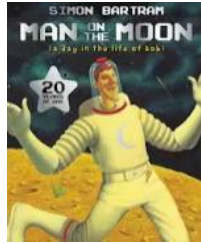
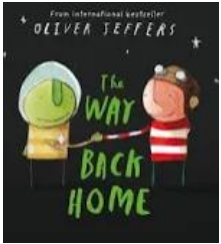

Literacy

Our focus story this week was The Way Back Home. The children drew a character and went on two adventures during the week. The first adventure was that there was someone else on the moon, who could it be? The second one was that the boy and the Martian met for lunch, what did they eat? New vocabulary included: ascended, spluttered, suddenly, navigating and glimmering.

At home you could try:

- Reading the words attached and spotting sounds when out and about.
- Using Lego, building blocks or paper squares to make different arrangements for 3, 4 and 5 e.g. for 3 this could be 2 square on top of each other and one at the side. Are there any other arrangements?
- Practising play lines and songs
