Outdoor Classroom Day

Dear parents/carers,

As an Eco-School, we are very passionate about making the most of our outdoor environment and always trying to increase the amount of outdoor learning that we do. With this in mind, we are taking part in Outdoor Classroom Day on **Thursday 19th May** (weather permitting).

On this day, we would like children in **EYFS to Year 5** to **come to school dressed suitably** for spending the day outside. They will need:

- Long trousers (jogger or leggings, no denim)
- T-shirt or long sleeved top (no vest tops)
- An additional warmer layer, such as a jumper
- Sunhat and sun cream, this could be applied in the morning before school
- Waterproof jacket
- Sensible shoes, such as old trainers or wellies (no flip flops or sandals)
- Water bottle

Please note, if your child is in **Year 6**, they will need to come to school in their uniform because they are having their “moving up” photo taken for the Newbury Weekly News. They will still take part in Outdoor Classroom Day but in their school uniform.

Over the course of the day, children will participate in a range of exciting outdoor activities linked to English, Maths and the wider curriculum. If we are forced to cancel the day due to bad weather, we will let you know via school comms and our Facebook page. In this situation, we would aim to rearrange to another date.
