Hector's World

Hector is a young dolphin who with his underwater friends is learning all about the internet. Over the course of six cartoons he explores ways to keep his information private and how to get help when he is worried.

The simple films make this resource suitable for very young children up to the age of seven years.

Learning objectives

The storylines help children understand why and how they should protect their identities online. Hector also introduces the idea that things online may not be as they seem and that sometimes other people may wish to be unkind or unpleasant. A key message is that children should ask a trusted adult for help if they are worried or upset by something they have seen online.
