- ✓ The last week's **attendance** was 94.6% for EYFS, Key Stage 1 and 92.6% for Key Stage 2 and for this week it was 96% for both schools.
- ✓ On Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> May, **Year 4 enjoyed a Roman themed day**. They designed their own Roman banquet and tasted some foods from Italy, completed timeline activities, took part in role-play with their Roman shields and made paper plate pizzas, showing all the things they have learnt about the Romans so far. #### **The Week in Pictures**


