

Topic ideas from pupils, parents and staff

Global Citizenship

- Link with another school in a different country.
- Organise an event that celebrates cultural diversity.
- Protect the rainforest/animal themed day.
- Create a display that says 'Welcome' or 'Hello' in all of the languages the children speak.
- Celebrate or learn about different cultural events around the world.
- Celebrate different religious festivals.

Healthy Living

- Learn about growing fruit and vegetables and the importance of eating in season.
- Work with the school canteen to plan a healthy and planet-friendly menu.
- Learn about how to make meals and snacks with whole foods. Learn about Ultra Processed Foods (UPFs).
- Invite sports coaches to come in and teach children how to look after our bodies.
- More cooking opportunities across the school.
- More sports competitions within school.
- Workshop from member of staff from Hungerford Primary School – cooking and gardening. Could include table-top flour milling and butter making.
- A day where each class plants a different flower or food to grow.
- Garden day.
- Take part in the Daily Mile.

School Grounds

- Create a wildlife friendly garden and develop the allotment area.
- Work with Kennet School – they have an allotment already.
- Start a gardening club.
- Plant fruit trees to create an orchard.
- Create a trim trail or an area that is like the adventure playground but different.
- Create a 'bug resort' with bug hotels etc. Learn about how important minibeasts are for the environment.
- Ban pesticide use on school grounds.
- Plant more trees around the field.
- Plant more hedges next to the fencing on the field.
