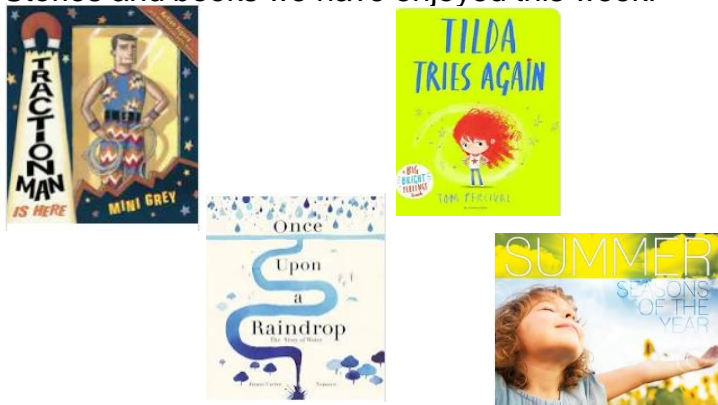

Literacy

This week we have been practicing our dictation skills and the children have worked hard to hold a sentence in their head before writing it down independently.

As the children have been doing so well in their phonic skills, we have introduced 5 new sounds: ay (play), ow (snow), ir (twirl), ou (shout) and oy (boy).

At home you could try:

- Reading with your child.
- Dictating a sentence for your child e.g The bus is red: We went to the park: The clown will do some tricks etc
- Practise reading and writing the tricky words.
- Recall number bonds to 5 or within 10.
- Creating your own puppet show.

Please check to see when it is your child's 'Be the Teacher'.

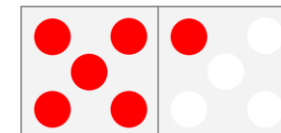
