



Literacy

In Literacy the children really enjoyed 'Wilo the Wisp'. They described a character and then we went on our adventures. First we thought about what funny thing might be in our thinks cloud and then we wondered what spell Evil Edna might put on us!

In phonics we have been learning the sounds ar, or, ur, oi and ow as well as the tricky words was and you.

At home you could try:

- Using objects to find different ways of making 6 and 7 using objects and arranging them into two groups.
- Reading the words attached, spotting digraphs.
- Creating a picture showing the water cycle
- Talking to your child about things from the past and how they have changed e.g. candles and oil lamps before electricity etc and creating a now and then poster.

Notes for Parents



Maths

In maths this week we were introduced to a die frame and the children explored the composition of 6 and 7 by using a double die frame. We used the nursery rhyme 5 little aliens as a starting point and then went on to extend the rhyme with more little aliens.



Understanding the World

This week we have been looking at things from the past and things that have changed. We looked at televisions from the past and thought about the differences to what they look like now. The children were interested to look at other things such as bicycles etc. We have also been thinking about the water cycle and learnt new vocabulary such as evaporation, precipitation and condensation!

Expressive Arts and Design

The children have really enjoyed their dance sessions this half-term and have loved moving in different ways, using ribbon sticks and scarves to enhance their dance!

They have also been making up their own shows, selling tickets and creating posters!

Please get your child to practise sounding out these words. If your child is struggling to read the words please sound it out for them, read the word to them and then get them to repeat it. E.g. j-a-zz then say sat. It is important that your child looks for any digraphs before sounding out the word.




