

Literacy

We continued our story from last week, inventing ways to get to a far off planet and then later thinking about what might happen once we were there. Ideas ranged from having strange foods to eat, sleepovers and house parties!

In phonics we have continued with learning another set of phase 3 sounds. These are z, zz, qu, ch and sh. From this point on all the sounds are either digraphs (2 letters 1 sound) and trigraphs (3 letters 1 sound).

At home you could try:

- Finding different ways of making 4 and 5, e.g. how many different arrangements of 4 pencils or 5 socks can you make?
- Spotting our new phase 3 sounds in books and practising reading the words attached.
- Continue practising songs and lines from our nativity play


<u>Understanding the World</u>

Expressive Arts and Design






Start in the clouds- over the top and round, up to the clouds, down below the runway and flick. Start in the clouds- down to the runway, round, up, down to the runway, flick.





Lower case ch formation patter - Start in the clouds- over the top and round. Start in the sky- straight down to the runway, up to the middle, over and flick





Lower case sh formation patter – Start in the clouds – back over and round and around the other way. Start in the sky- straight down to the runway, up to the middle, over and flick
